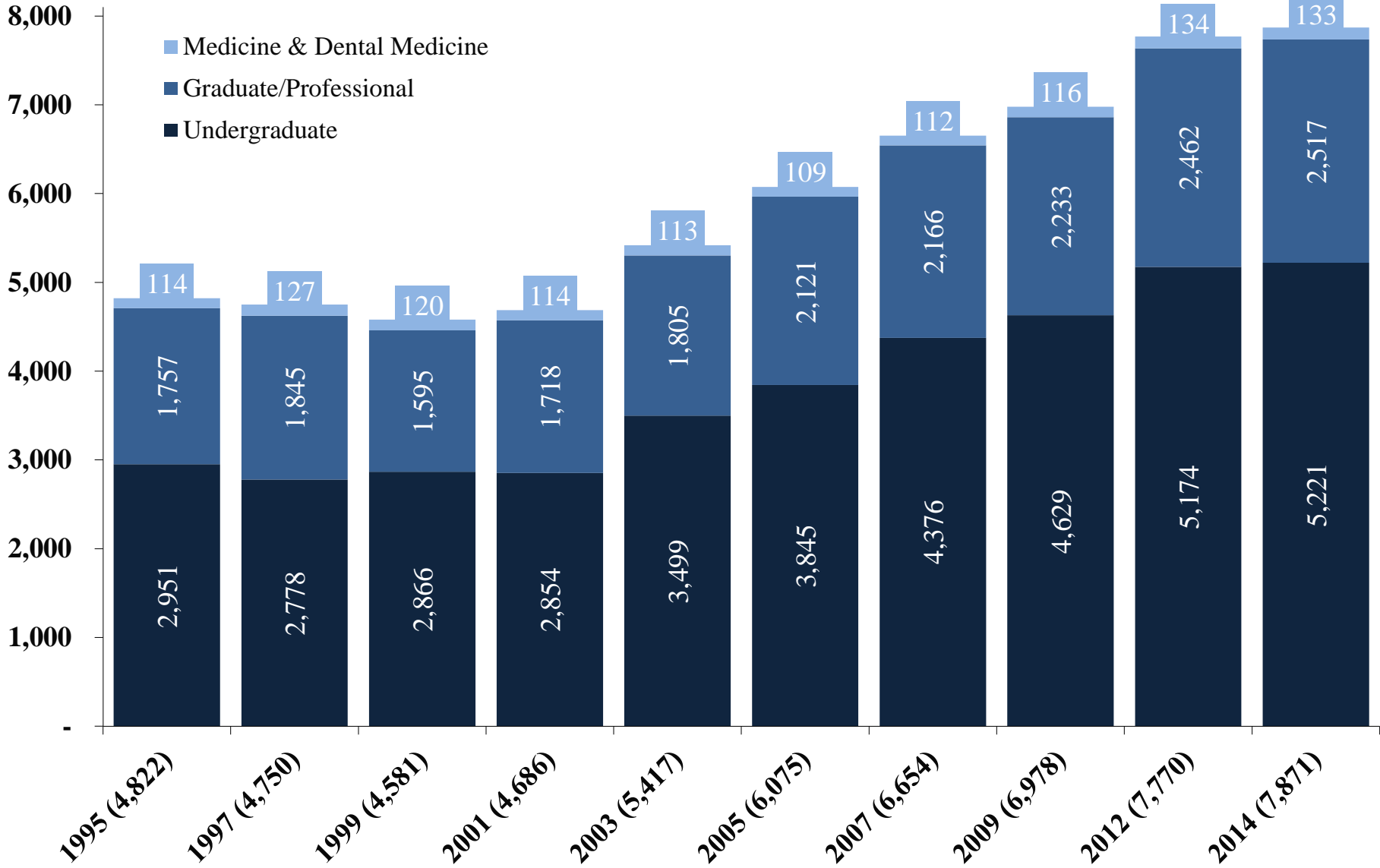

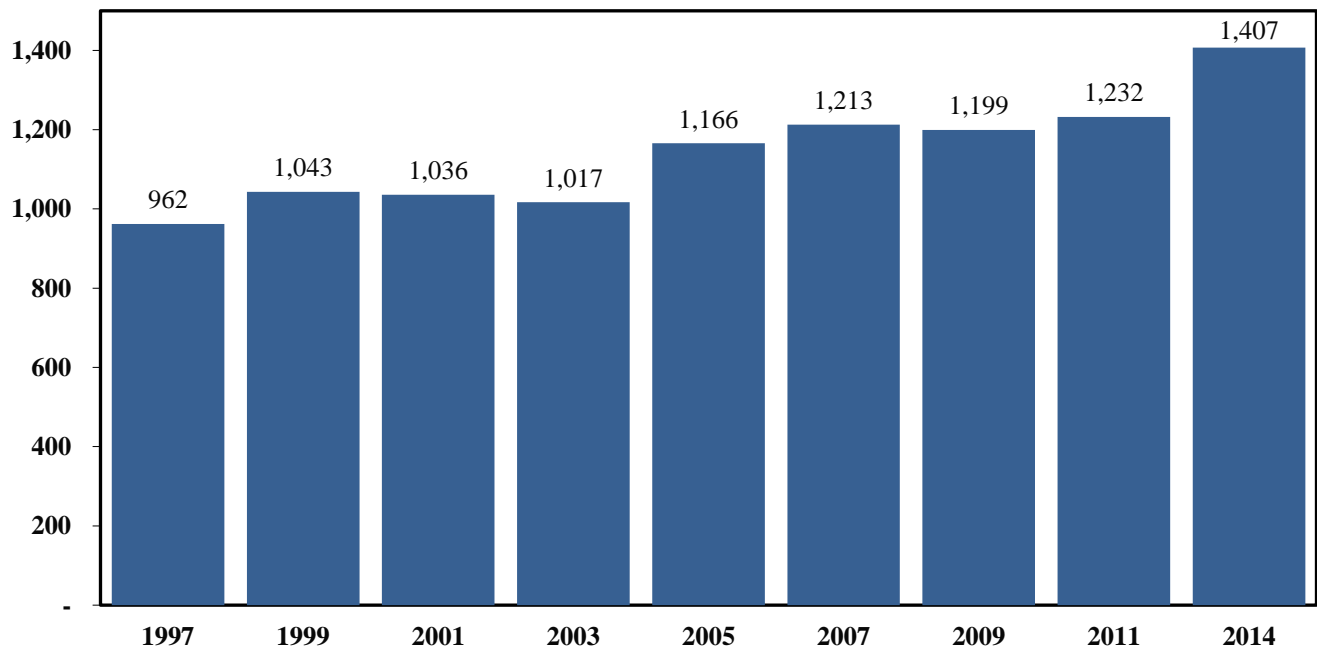

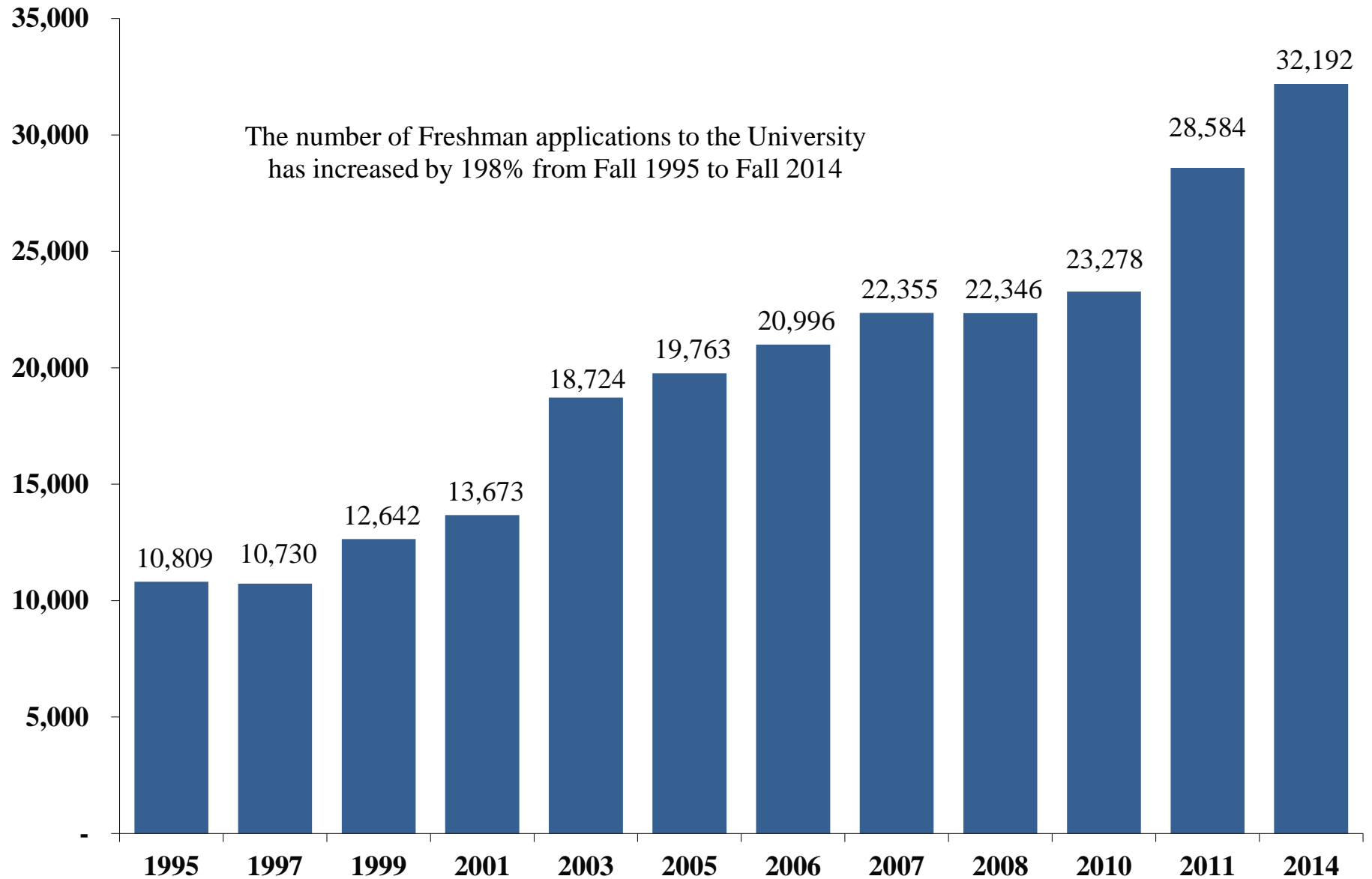

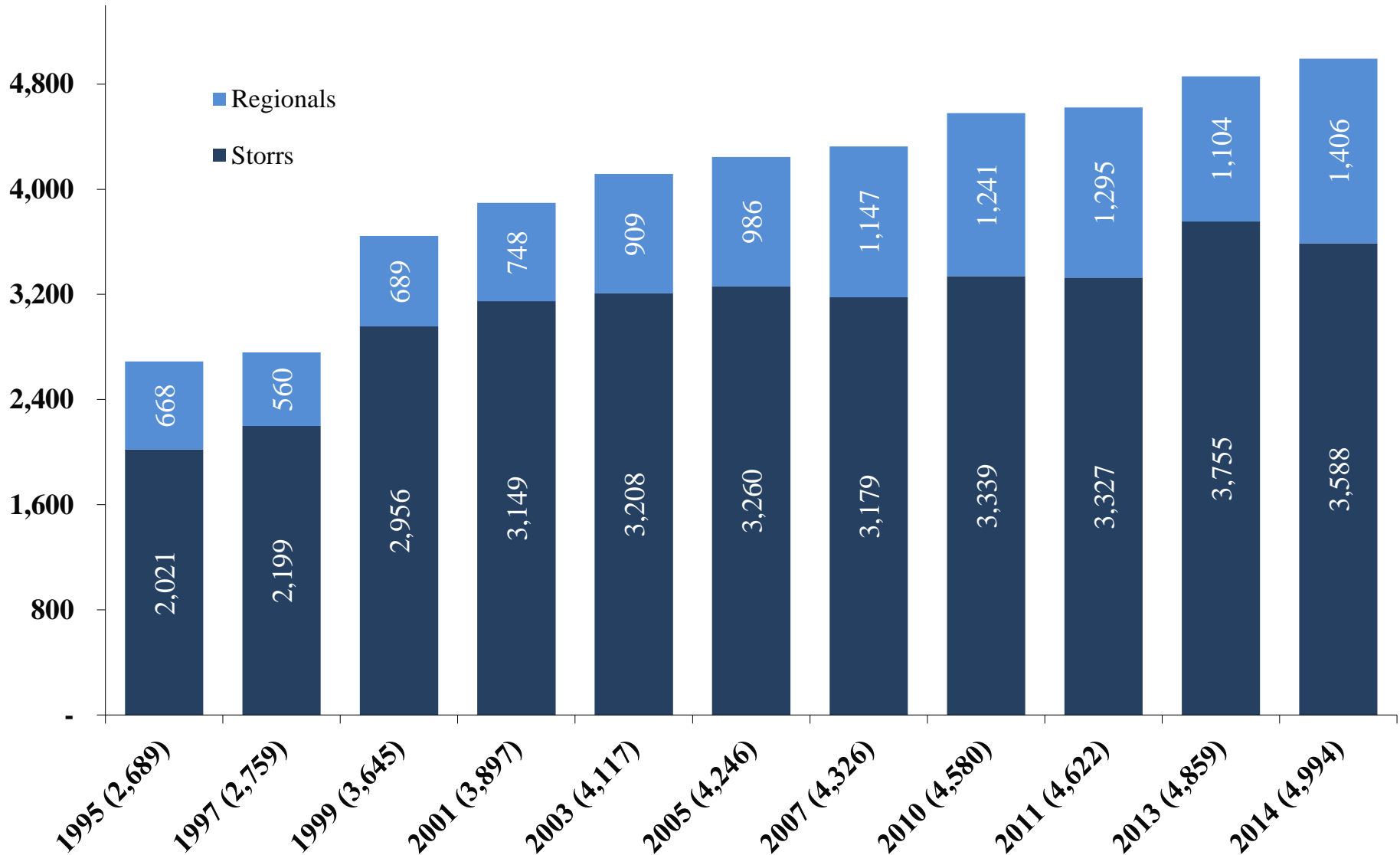

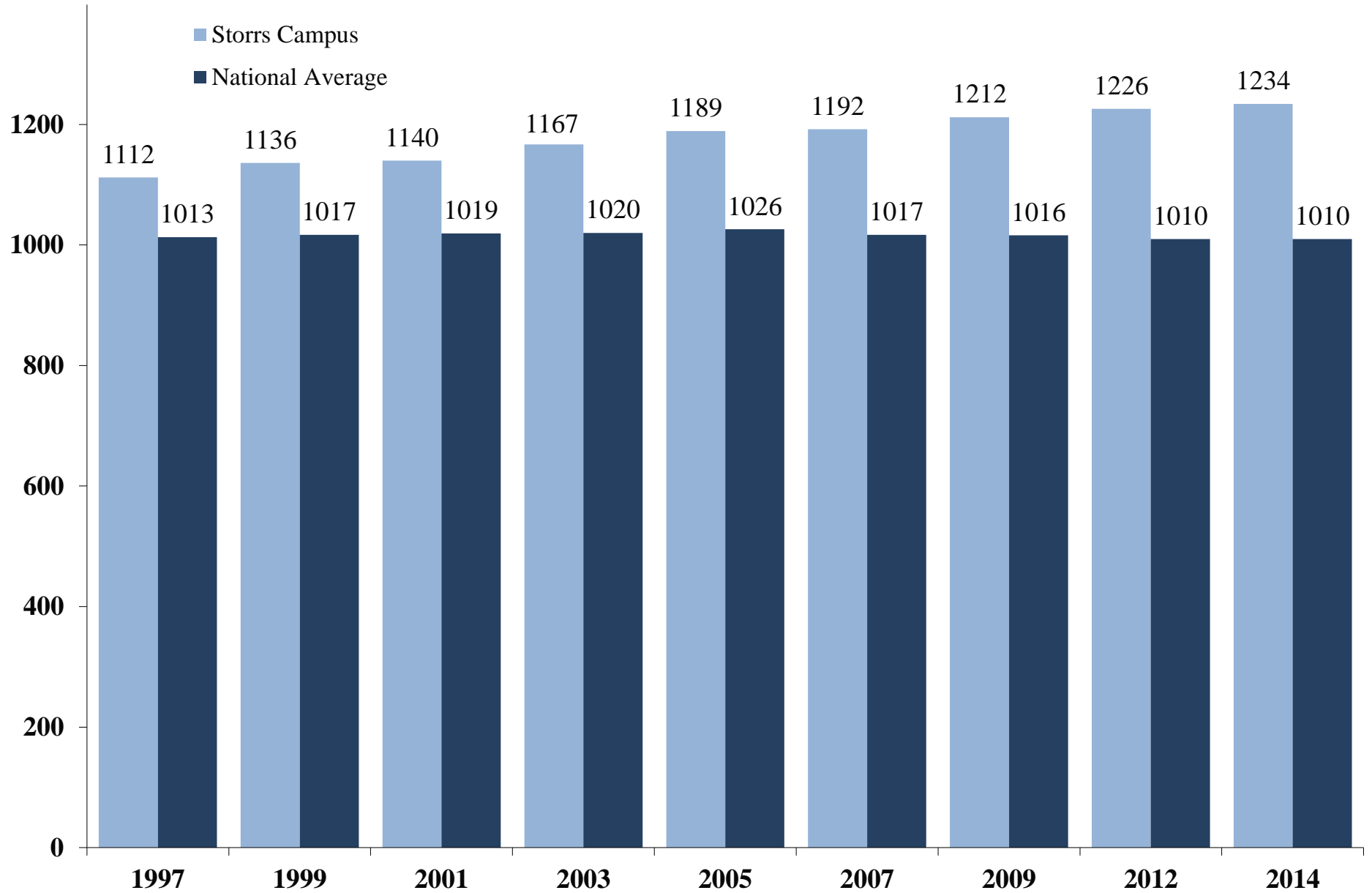
*First semester Freshman enrollment increased by 86% from Fall 1995 to Fall 2014

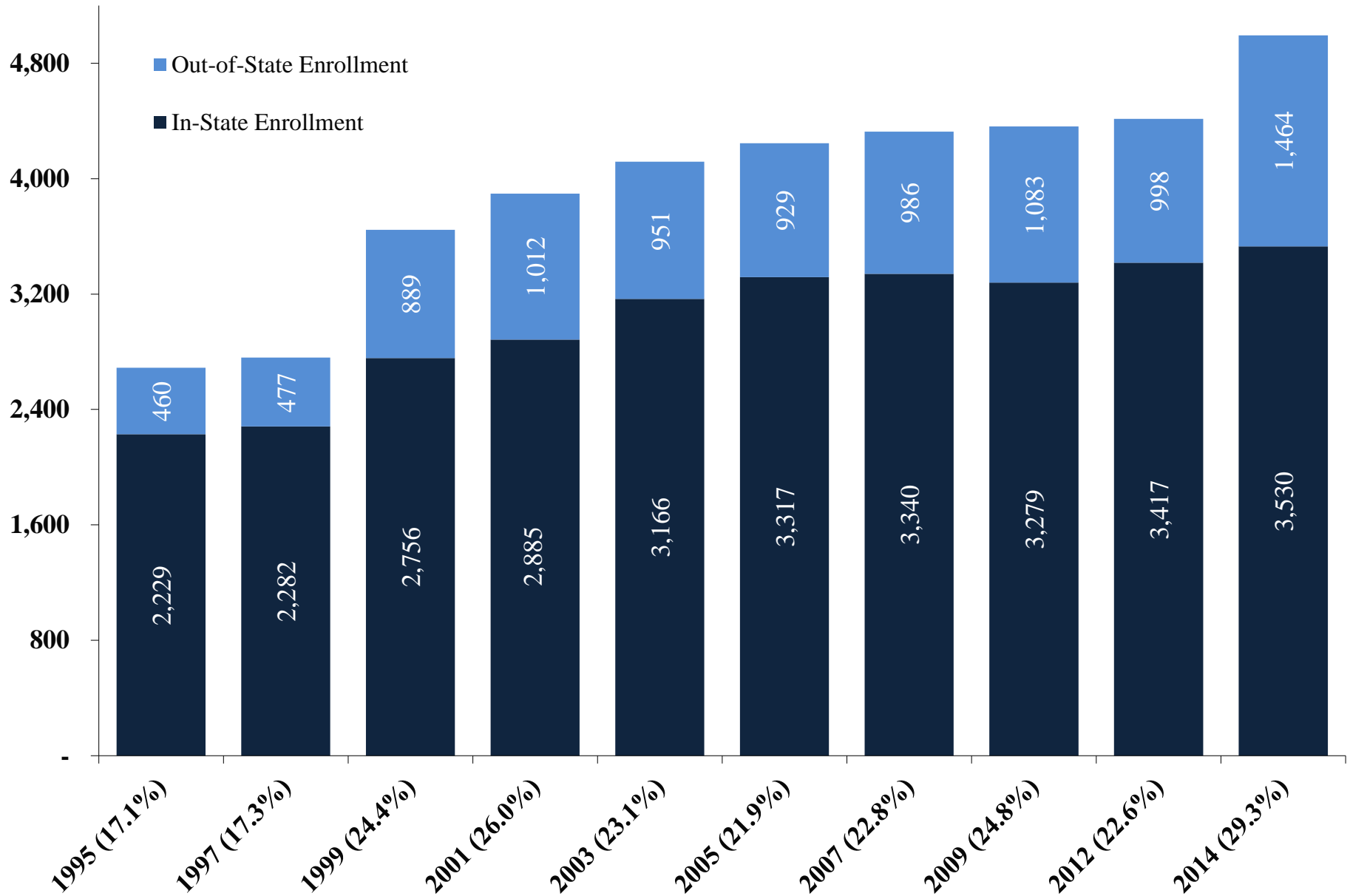

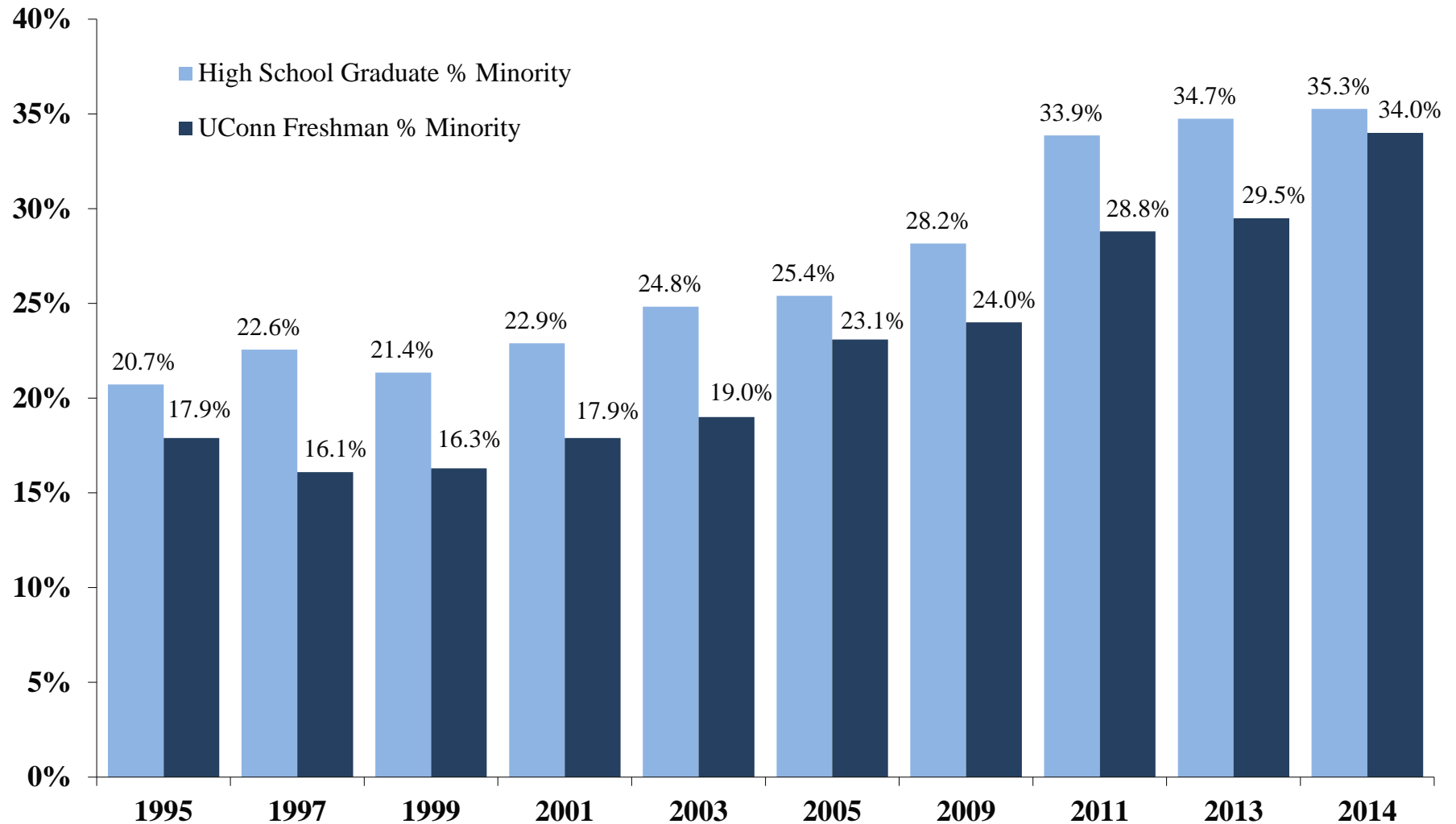

University of Connecticut - Storrs & Regional Campuses Freshman In-State and Out-of-State Enrollment - Fall 1995-2014



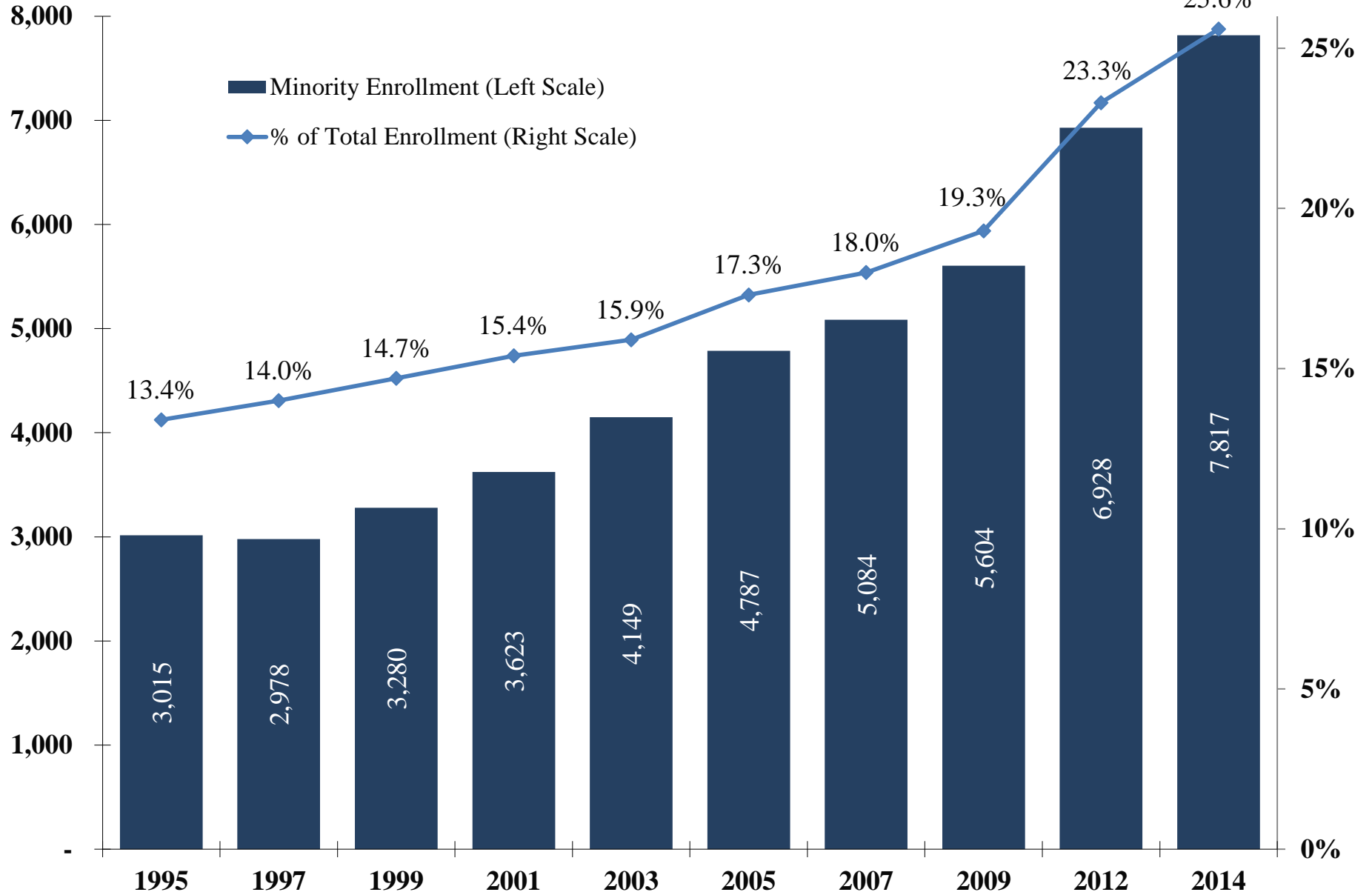
University of Connecticut - Storrs & Regional Campuses Freshman Minority Enrollment Trends for Entry Fall 1995-2014



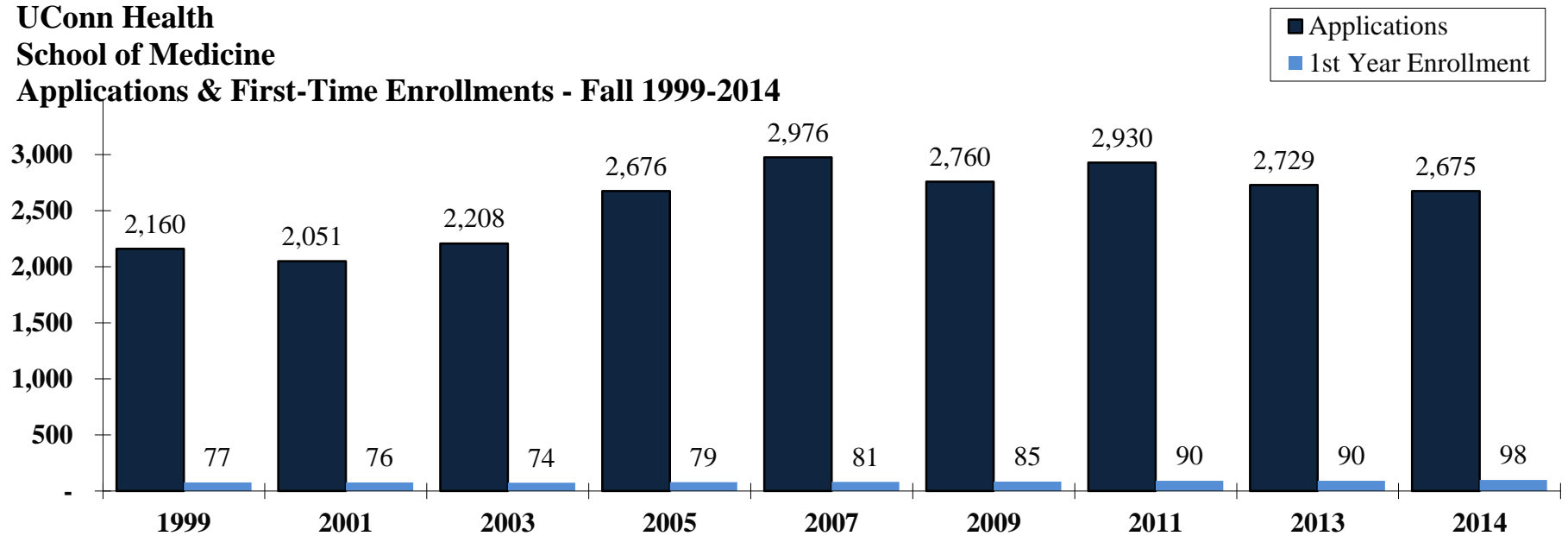

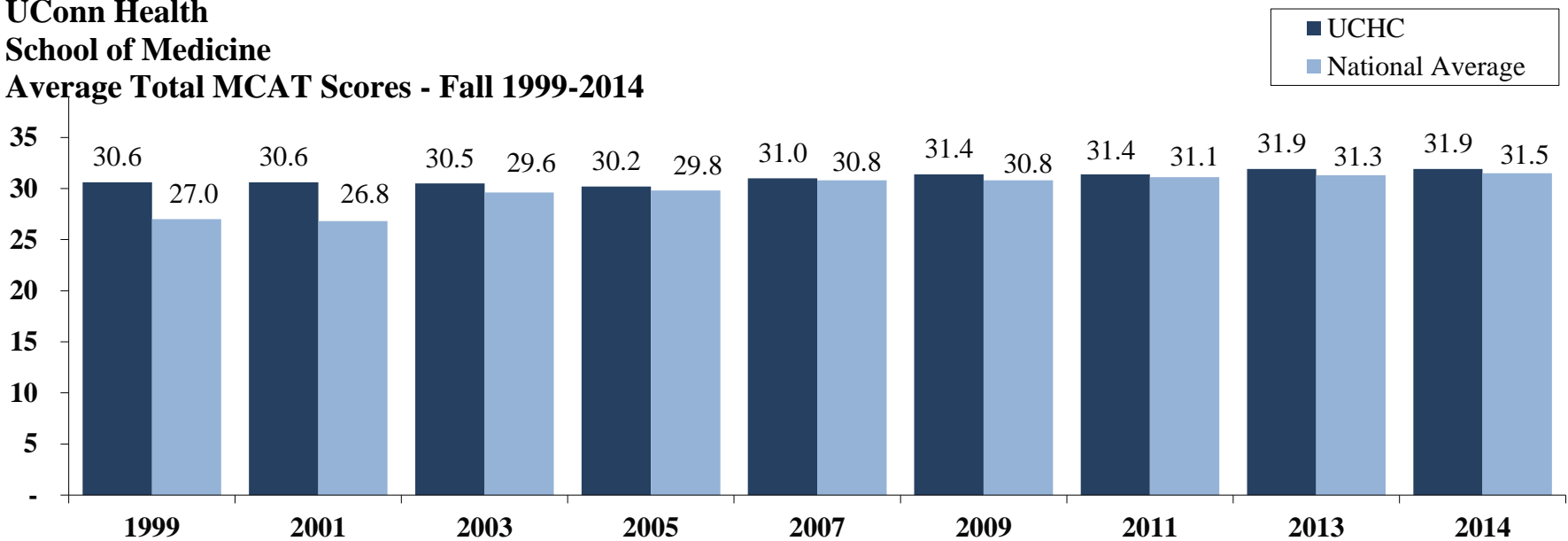
Total Minority Enrollment - Fall 1995-2014



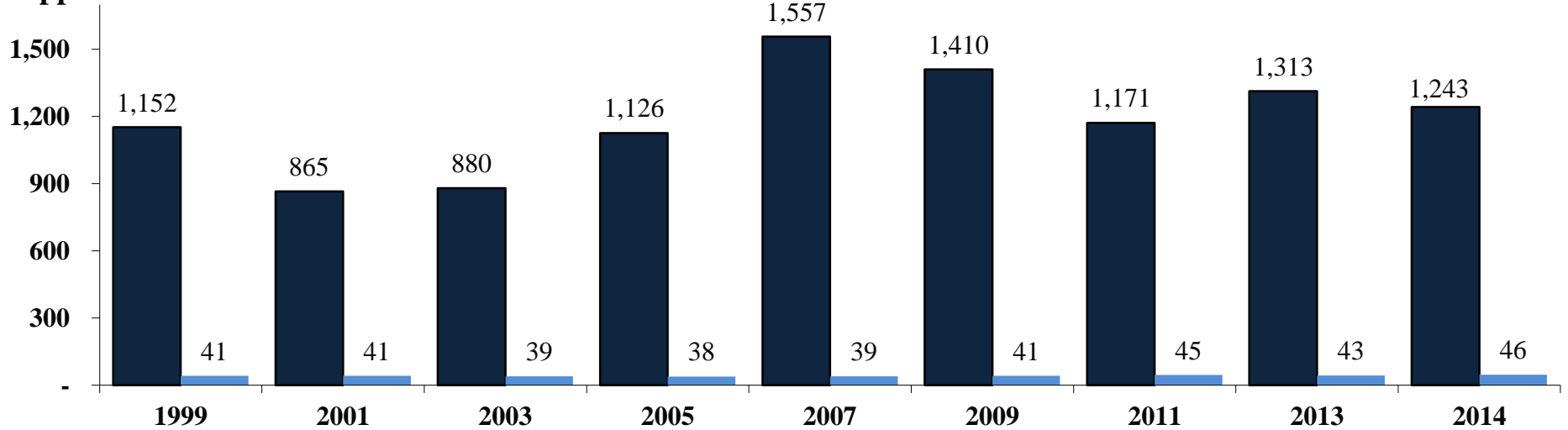

Applications & First-Time Enrollments - Fall 1999-2014**



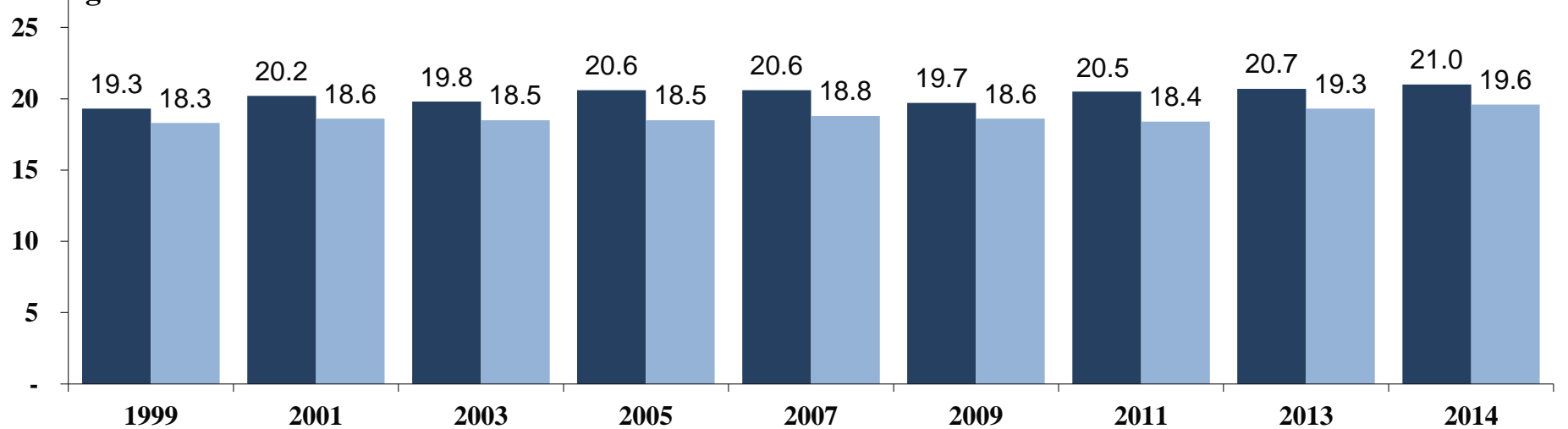

Average Total MCAT Scores - Fall 1999-2014**



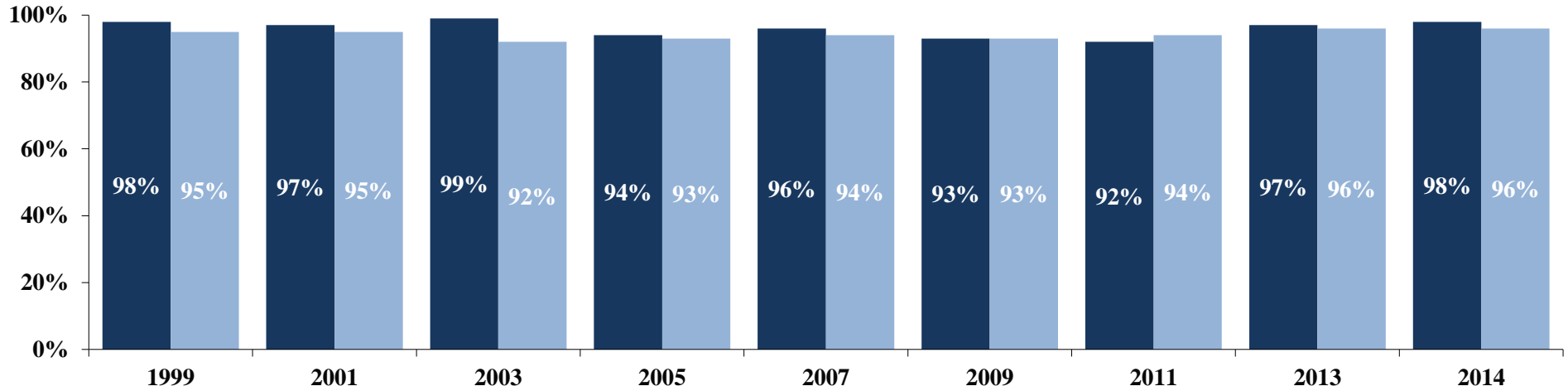

Applications & First-Time Enrollments - Fall 1999-2014**



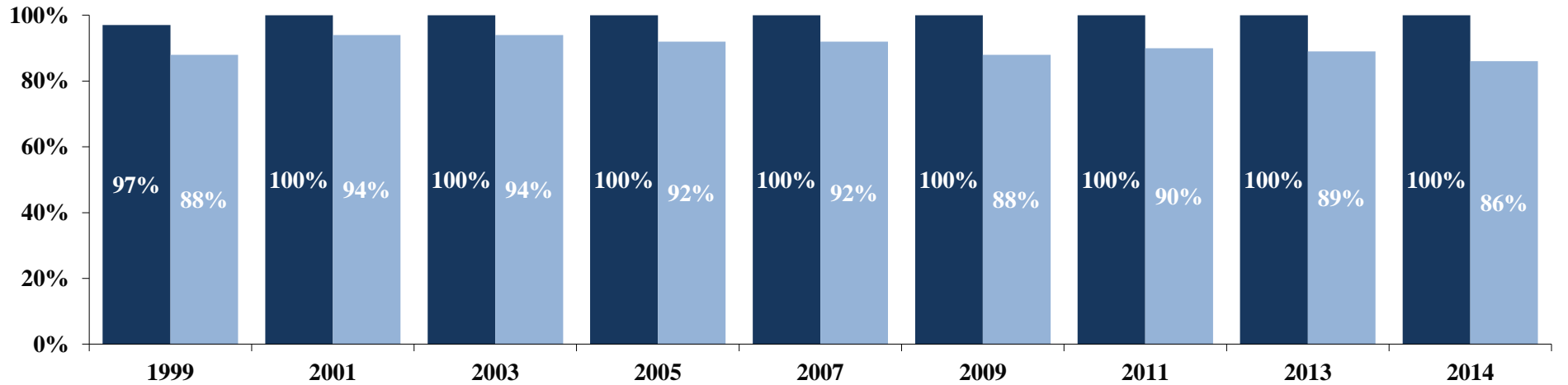
